Academics:

Reading: In reading this week, we finished up our first module on learning challenges throughout the world. The students wrapped up this unit by writing a 4 paragraph essay describing reading challenges they have and describing strategies they can use to overcome these challenges. They also created a bookmark describing these challenges/strategies that I will laminate so they can use it for reference. Next week, we will begin our next module which focuses on frogs and has the students reading poetry, porquoi stories, and non-fiction text.

Math: During our math block, the students have been practicing using estimation with multiplication and division problems. We also worked on division problems with remainders. Midway through this week, we refocused our efforts on solving multi-step word problems. The students are using key words to help them figure out which operation to use to solve the problems. However, I have also been putting a lot of emphasis on really thinking about what is occurring in the "story". For example, if food is eaten, we will likely subtract or if we have several bags of items, that might mean we need to multiply. We will continue our work with multi-step problems next week.

- On Tuesday, December 19, the 3rd grade students will be taking part in a Holidays Around the World activity.
