Academics:

Reading: In reading this week, we completed mClass testing to determine your child's current reading level. I will send home the parent letters as soon as all testing is complete (hopefully next week). Next week, we will get back into our reading/writing curriculum. The class will be writing a porquoi story as a group to practice narrative writing. The following week, students will work independently to write their own porquoi story. We will also be spending some time focusing on comparative and superlative adjectives (i.e. big, bigger, biggest) and determining the meaning of unknown words.

Math: During our math block, we have been learning different strategies to find the area of a figure. The students have learned that they can simply count the square units (if they are drawn), use the formula Length x Width (A = L x W), or breaking up large areas into smaller rectangles, and then add the areas together to find the area of the whole shape. Next week, we will continue more practice with area, including how to find the area in complex figures when some of the side lengths are missing. Then we will begin to teach the students how to find the perimeter of a shape by adding up all of the sides.
