Academics:

Reading: After break, we will begin our new EL unit that focuses on frogs and amphibians using a non-fiction text. The students will be using a very entertaining non-fiction text to practice analyzing informational text and using text features to help them comprehend. They will also be writing a porquoi tale as well as informational paragraphs to teach others about a frog in which they are particularly interested. This unit will last the next several weeks, so get ready to hear lots of interesting facts about amphibians!

Math: In math, we will continue to focus on multiplication and division. We are finishing up our unit on algebra before we leave for Thanksgiving and will turn to estimating products and quotients after we return. The students will be using their rounding skills as well as their multiplication and division facts to solve the problems.
