Academics:

Reading: During our ELA block, the students have been reading a narrative non-fiction story about Booker T. Washington and his efforts to learn how to read after his family was freed from slavery. Next week, the students will be reflecting on challenges they have fought through as they have learned to read over the past few years. They will take this work and write a "reading contract" to help explain strategies they can use to overcome these reading challenges. The students will work through the writing process to complete this essay.

Math: In math, we are beginning to work on multiplication and division word problems using multiple strategies—drawing pictures, arrays, skip counting, repeated addition/subtraction, etc. We are heavily focusing on the "situation" that is occurring in each problem and trying to envision what the problem is telling us. In that way, the students can best decide which operation will help them solve the problem (multiplication if there are several groups that all have the same number of objects or division if we know how many objects there are and we want to split them into equal groups).
