Academics:

Reading: During our ELA block, the students have been reading picture books that focus on children who face challenges in having access to books or education. We have been learning how to find the gist of a story (main idea) by using the "Somebody...In...Wanted...But...So" graphic organizer to focus the information on the most important aspects of the story. We also began writing short constructed responses to a question about a text. Next week, the students will be assessed on their speaking and listening skills in a small group discussion. We will also determine the gist and the lesson of a new story, Nasreen's Secret School.

Math: In math, the students are doing a great job with the addition and subtraction algorithm. At times, I have noticed some students confusing which operation to use or having trouble with their basic addition and subtraction facts. It would be great to have your child practice those to make sure they are fresh in their mind. Next week, we will focus on addition and subtraction word problems and strategies we can use to determine which operation is appropriate for solving it (keywords, bar model, etc.). Much of our attention will be focused on multi-step word problems - those that involve adding and subtracting in order to find the correct answer.
